School Data

Sunny Brae provincial assessment data improved by double digits at the end of '23-'24 school year. Every assessment area is trending in the right direction. Writing remains the largest struggle across the board at Sunny Brae (regardless of grade, EL/FI). This is the number one focus for the administration this year.

Nick said a huge reason for the increase in the assessments is due to 'Teaming'. Groups of teachers can meet to discuss behavioral and academic concerns & solutions.

School Improvement Plan

Also includes four district goals:

- 1) Every child will read & write at grade level.
- 2) Every child will have grade-level proficiency in numeracy.
- 3) Every student is to feel safe & included.
- 4) Every student will graduate high school.

Two academic goals from '23-'24 school year were met and confirmed by data.

Sunny Brae is a PBIS (Positive Behaviour Incubator School). Erica led this at the district and is now our VP. There are now 14 volunteers on this board at Sunny Brae (educators). Have defined three areas: mentorship, lab (learning and tracking behaviours) and learning (proactive instead of reactive).

There's a heavy reliance on school values. Every conversation with students will come back to the values.

Krista & Erica are teaching VPs (English & Math, respectively). Having two VPs allows for the mentorship and growth of new teachers in the school (87% of teachers at Sunny Brae are within their first three years of teaching).

Myblueprint, which is used at Moncton High, will be taught in grades 6-8, to ensure familiarity and use by the time students reach Moncton High.

New this year is Guided Block. The first fifty minutes of every day will be spent learning school values, building connections and reading comprehension. Eight comprehension strategies. Read & respond; this skill crosses over to all subjects. Will also be used for any required interventions.

Two brands new school logos! One was voted on by the PSSC, to be unveiled soon!
